

Halo Hoops Summer League

Format & Rules

6-9 Yr Olds

Game Format

Divisions are: 6-7 Girls, 8-9 Girls, 6-7 Boys, 8-9 Boys

*Age as of Oct. 15, 2008

Weekly games played on Tuesdays or Thursdays

No practices provided, unless arranged by coach

Players receive: team tee shirt & Bible material

General Game Rules

- 4-on-4 Games using junior-size ball on short court
- Coach must be on court at all times during 6-7's games
 - to assist players vocally without causing interference of the game
- Rosters have max. of 8 players
- All players will play at least 20 min. each game
- Warm-up period is a minimum of 5 min. prior to Prayer & Game Time
- Substitutions allowed at dead ball situations
- Site coordinator may excuse persons who do not abide by Halo Commitment

Time & Scoring Format

- Two 20-minute running halves
- 5 min. halftime
- 30 sec. break between quarters
- One 30 sec. timeout per team per half (no T.O. last 2 min. of each half)
- Running clock (no stoppage during timeouts)
- 1 Basket = 2 pts., 1 Free Throw = 2 pts.

Offense Rules

- Violations called as follows:
 - 6-7's if continuous
 - 8-9's if not corrected immediately
- If tie game, no overtime
- No 3-second lane violation for 6-7's
- Lane violation is 4 seconds for 8-9's

Free Throw Rules

- Shooting Fouls = 1 free throw (only if missed shot)
- Non-shooting Fouls = 1 free throw after 7 team fouls in half
- Free Throw Shoot-off
 - During halftime, each player shoots 1 free throw worth 2 pts.
 - If unequal # of players, team with fewer players shoots to make up difference

Defense Rules

- Must play man-to-man defense
- No double teaming
- No pressing, defensive team must get back past half-court line

Court Regulations

- Goal Height
 - 8 ft. for 6-7's
 - 9 ft. for 8-9's
- Free Throw Line
 - 10 ft. for 6-7's
 - 12 ft. for 8-9's
- Short Court Dimensions
 - 60' x 40'

Tournament Format

Round Robin – each team plays all other teams one time
