

Halo Hoops Summer Youth League

Rules: 10–18 Yr Olds

GENERAL

Current state high school basketball rules apply, with exceptions listed below

Modifications to equipment

Ball size: 28.5 for 10–11 Boys and all girls, Official for 12–18 Boys

Court size: 60'x40'

Goal height: 10'

Free throw line: 13' for 10–11's, 15' for all others

Maximum 8 players per team

Age determined as of Oct. 15

Minimum 12 min. playing time per game per player

TIME

Running clock

3 min. pre-game warmup

Each team is allowed two 30 sec. timeouts per game (can't use during final 2 min.)

SCORING

No 3 pt. shot

If tied at end of regulation, play sudden death overtime

DEFENSE

Requirements

Man-to-man defense

10–13's restriction: Full court press allowed only during final 2 min. of game

BEHAVIOR

Disagreement with a rule infraction (not judgment call) must be presented respectfully by coach in following order:

1. To referee at halftime or during timeout

2. To gym director at halftime

If issue not resolved, coach must e-mail league director within 3 days of occurrence

Players may not dispute calls with officials or use offensive language

First offense: warning to team

Second offense: technical foul applied to team

Gym director will excuse from gym anyone not abiding by Halo Commitment

PLAYOFFS

Single-elimination tournament

Seedings determined according to regular season record

If 2 teams have identical records, seeding determined by:

1. winner of head-to-head game

2. margin of victory in head-to-head games

3. best record against higher-seeded teams

4. coin flip
